1. Policy 9.700 Weapons at School

The public consultation period has ended and there was no public input to be considered by the Committee.

Motion: Committee recommends the Board approve revisions to Policy 9.700 Weapons at School as presented.

2. Policy 9.960 Course Fees for Non-enrolling Students

Given there has been increasing interest from non-enrolling students and outside educational institutions for access to our educational program and use of facilities, the current policy should be updated. This policy should provide the requirements for allowing student access to school district resources, including students with unique and identified needs.

A draft revision was presented and discussed at the committee meeting, including the equitable distribution of educational resources and student liability. The draft policy will continue to be developed, including consultation with Ms. Cindy Miller – District Principal of Learner Support, and brought back to committee in June.

3. Policy 6.480 Partial Credit

Mr. Margerm outlined that Policy 6.480 Partial Credit is now obsolete and covered within Ministry regulations.
