1. CALL TO ORDER

- Chairperson Williams heard that we are around the 50th anniversary of Carolfest . It's a long standing traditional in the district and it's the official start of the holiday season. Carolfest will be sent December 3, 2025 , showtimes at 5pm & 6pm.
- Trustee Michell sent her regrets.
